



TUMAREN CAMP | LAIKIPIA | NO. 27.194 E36 57.444

Tumaren Camp is located on a 13,000 acre conservancy within the larger conservation and community area of Laikipia. The camp faces South West and overlooks a wide open plain with a waterhole and salt lick. Each group has their own guide throughout the stay.

FACILITIES

Main sitting room with its own toilet.

Main Dining Room.

Private Dining and sitting room - Tent 8 - for those wanting to eat alone / families

Tent 6 & 7 can be taken separately with Tent 8 as their own dining and sitting room

20 metre swimming pool with a large pool house, bar and changing room with toilet.

Meals can be enjoyed here as well the other two dining rooms.

Shop

Private airstrip - walking distance to the camp.

Wi-Fi - at our offices in a guest Wi-Fi tent - about 200 metres from the pool house. None in the main camp.

ACCOMODATION

7 Large en-suite safari tents with verandas - 3 to the left of the communal area and 4 to the right.

4 Tents have dividers for extra privacy if needed.

Private entrances to each tent.

Solar lighting

Flush toilets and hot running water at all times.

Tent 1: Tent with a divider: Double bed and a single bed

Tent 2: Double bed

Tent 3: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds and an extra day bed if needed

Tent 4: Double

Tent 5: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds and an extra day bed if needed

Tent 6: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds

Tent 7: Family tent with a divider - Double bed, twin beds and an extra day bed if needed

Each tents can have beds added if needed.

We have a baby cot with bedding we can set up on request.

Extras: Nanny at an extra cost

Mountain Biking - on request and availability

Guests plan daily with their guide – there is an activities and information pack in each tent and communal area.
